



HOW DO I QUALIFY?

To qualify for the 2018 AMSOIL AMA Amateur National Arenacross Championship at the Orleans Arena in Las Vegas you must participate in at least one round in your region. To understand how the qualifying system works, it helps to know that country is divided into five different geographical regions consisting of the East, Central, Mid-West, Northwest, South and West.

The top 3 riders overall from the South, East, Central, and Midwest regions will qualify for the Amateur National Arenacross Championships (ANAC). These three riders obtained the most amount of overall points in their class.

The top 4 riders overall from the West region will qualify for ANAC. These will be the top 4 riders that obtained the most amount of points in their class in the west region.

I QUALIFIED IN MORE THAN ONE REGION:

Riders are allowed to compete in more than one region. However, the first region the rider qualifies from will be the region the rider advances from to ANAC.

If the region ends on the same day (Central and East)- the rider will advance from the region the rider placed better in.
